

Communities In Schools of Chesterfield's (CIS-C) mission is to surround students with a community of support, empowering them to stay in school and achieve in life. We are a dropout prevention program that works with community partners to provide wrap-around services and programming to help students. We see the tremendous needs within our own community and the community resources that exist; our role is to bridge the gap between the needs and the resources. Currently, we support 11,000 K-12 students across 11 high-need Chesterfield schools. Our team of Site Coordinators work inside each school, collaborating with school staff, community partners, and families to ensure equitable academic opportunities for our students!

About NAP

NAP, created by the General Assembly in 1981, is a program to **encourage individuals and businesses to make charitable donations to organizations** serving economically disadvantaged people. The program incentivizes donors through tax credits (up to 65%) applied against their Virginia state income tax liability.

NAP tax credits allow taxpayers to support a worthy cause while also saving on taxes. As an added "plus," the contribution is 100% deductible on the taxpayer's federal return.

- Donations by individuals must be a minimum of \$500
- Donations by businesses must be a minimum of \$616
